ORDINANCE 2020-1575

An Ordinance Amending Section 2-663 of the Mequon Municipal Code, Reducing the Number of Mayoral Appointments to the Mequon Nature Preserve Board of Directors from Three (3) to One (1)

**SECTION I**

Section 2-663 of the Mequon Code of Ordinances is amended as follows: (NOTE: added text is **bolded and double-underlined** and deleted text is ~~struck through~~)

- (a) The board shall consist of 12 members.
- (b) The mayor shall nominate ~~three~~ **one** of the members as a citizen members.
- (c) The Ozaukee Washington Land Trust shall appoint ~~three other~~ **one** members pursuant to its own rules.
- (d) The balance of the members shall be appointed pursuant to the articles of incorporation and bylaws of Mequon Nature Preserve, Inc. by vote of the sitting members.
- (e) The city shall endeavor, but shall not be obligated, to appoint citizen members who have educational or professional backgrounds in land preservation, natural sciences, environmental education, financing, fund raising or other appropriate disciplines.

**SECTION II**

The terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any term or provision of this ordinance is found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION III**

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in contravention to this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION IV**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and on the day after its publication.
