Public meeting set for proposed improvements along WIS 57 in Milwaukee County

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is hosting a public involvement meeting to discuss the proposed improvements along WIS 57 (Green Bay Road) in the village of Brown Deer in Milwaukee County.

Project Highlights:

- Improving 3.4 miles of roadway from Teutonia Avenue to Mequon Road
- New roundabout at WIS 57 and Teutonia Avenue
- New at-grade signalized intersection at WIS 57 and WIS 100 (Brown Deer Road)
- Rehabilitating the Brown Deer Road bridges over the Milwaukee River
- New traffic signal at Deerbrook Trail and Brown Deer Road
- Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2021

The meeting will follow an informal, open house format with WisDOT representatives available to discuss the proposed project in detail. Attendees may stop in at their convenience and view exhibits, meet with project staff, ask questions, and provide feedback. WisDOT encourages property and business owners, interested residents, and other stakeholders to attend the meeting.
