

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is hosting a public involvement meeting for the I-43/ County Line Road and Port Washington Road Bridges Rehabilitation Project. The purpose of the meeting is to:

- Provide firsthand information about project content, milestones and next steps
- Continue communication between WisDOT and the local communities and businesses

Project Overview

WisDOT will resurface and rehabilitate the County Line Road and Port Washington Road bridges over I-43 to improve ride quality and extend the life of the existing structures.

Next Steps

WisDOT will be completing final plans this Fall. Depending on funding, construction could begin as early as Spring of 2019 and take about 5 months to complete. Prior to construction, WisDOT will provide notification to local municipalities, residents and emergency responders regarding construction schedule and plans.
