City of Mequon Weekly Bulletin Image Submission



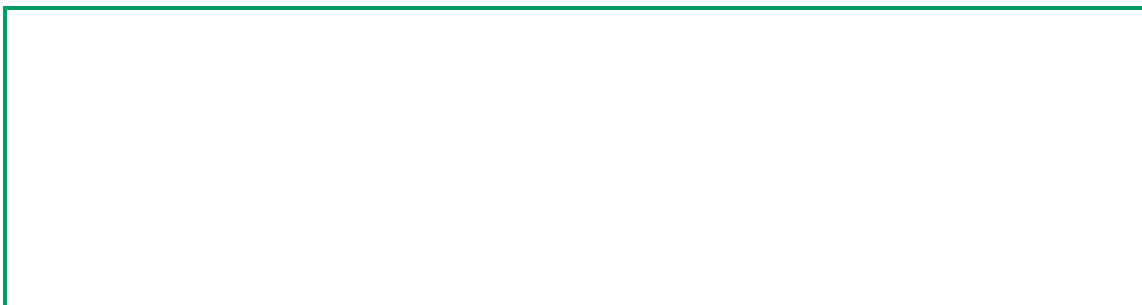
