Preemption Sensors Installed to Aid Emergency Vehicles

Emergency preemption equipment has been installed in Mequon as part of the WISDOT reconstruction efforts. Emergency preemption is a sensor located on traffic signals to give responding emergency vehicles a green light in the direction of travel while changing all other signals to red. If drivers notice a solid white light above the traffic lights, it means an emergency vehicle is approaching from behind. If drivers see a flashing white light, it means the traffic signal has been preempted to allow for an emergency vehicle to proceed through the intersection. Many emergency vehicles, including Mequon's vehicles, have a sending unit (strobe light) built into the lightbar to activate the preemption equipment while the vehicle's emergency lights are flashing. WISDOT has updated the equipment on traffic signals along Port Washington Road, Mequon Road, and Cedarburg Road.

In addition, the Southern Ozaukee Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department Board approved the new logo for the SOFD at their November 20 meeting. The logo was created by a collaboration of Mequon and Thiensville personnel. It will take some time for all department uniforms, badges, and vehicle badging to be changed over to the new logo.



Ways to Vote in Special Election on Tuesday, January 10

District 8 residents will have a special election on Tuesday, January 10, 2023, to elect a new alderperson. Requests from voters to mail an absentee ballot can be made at any time, however ballots will not be mailed until mid-December. Voters will also have an opportunity to vote absentee in-person December 27 – January 6, during regular City Hall hours. Please be aware that City Hall will be open on Friday, December 30 from 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M. and will be closed on Monday, January 2.

Senator Alberta Darling to Retire Mid-Term

On December 1, State Senator Alberta Darling ended her 32-year political career and retired. First elected to the state Assembly in 1990, Darling has served in the state Senate since 1992 and authored more than 200 bills that became law. Darling represented the 8th Senate District that covers southern parts of Ozaukee and Washington counties, northeastern parts of Waukesha county, and the northern Milwaukee suburbs. A special election will need to be called by Governor Evers to fill out the remainder of her four-year term.



Temporary Traffic Patterns in Place Along Mequon Road

In December, crews will be televising Sanitary Sewers with CCTV (closed circuit television) in advance of WisDOT's Mequon Road resurfacing project from Cedarburg Road (STH 57) to Port Washington Road (CTH W), which will take place in 2027. The sewer televising is to determine if any relay or rehabilitation work is required prior to road construction. Traffic pattern modifications will vary throughout the corridor as crews progress and move to complete segments along Mequon Road. Televising work is anticipated to begin in December and be completed by January. Please remember to slow down when driving through work zones.

Nomination papers can be circulated for aldermanic seats up for reelection in April 2023 as of December 1. Aldermanic terms in Districts 2, 3 and 5 will expire in April.
