

City Receives Rating Upgrade from Moody's Investors Services

On January 23, Moody's Investor Services upgraded the City of Mequon's general obligation and issuer ratings by two levels from A1 to Aa2. The new rating reflects the City's healthy tax base, resident income, and high full value per capita within the Milwaukee metro area with moderate long-term liabilities and a low fixed-costs ratio. In addition, the City maintains strong financial reserves with particularly large fund balances in the sewer and water enterprise funds. This action concludes a review that was initiated in November in conjunction with the release of a new US Cities and Counties ratings methodology. The full press release can be found here.


