



## **Ozaukee County Transit Services Seeking Resident Input**

Ozaukee County is considering offering a new transit service called the Ozaukee Flex-Bus. This service would add on-demand service between Ozaukee and Milwaukee Counties, along Port Washington Road from Mequon to Port Washington, and along Cedarburg and Green Bay Roads into Saukville. The service could potentially run in both directions every hour Monday – Saturday. This service would be in addition to the Shared Ride Taxi and Ozaukee Express Commuter Bus. Ozaukee County Transit Services is hosting a public workshop at the Weyenberg Library on Tuesday, March 7, from 5:00 P.M. – 6:30 P.M. to seek input on potential routes (see map below) and if they meet the travel needs of residents, business owners, and employees. 
## Sign-up for County's Emergency Notification Alert System


As the Police Department continues to work with Ozaukee County as they assume emergency dispatching responsibilities on behalf of the City, the Department would like to advise Mequon residents of an emergency notification alerting system that is available to all residents of Ozaukee County. Residents have long known that they may call 911 for police, fire or medical assistance. Additionally, the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office, Public Health Department, and Emergency Management Division participate in a mass alert notification system called Alert Sense, which is similar to a reverse of the 911 system. The County Dispatch Center, either on its own or at the request of City Officials, can send voice and text messages that alert the community to a variety of emergency and non-emergency circumstances, such as a crime/imminent danger, evacuation alert, hazardous materials, local area emergency, or missing persons/Amber Alert.
