Mequon Road-OIT Construction Update



The Mequon Road-Ozaukee Interurban Trail Improvement Project is currently on schedule and is anticipated to conclude in late October. Last week, crews removed pavement, curb and sidewalk on the westbound (north) side of Mequon Road. The contractor also prepared the gravel base and set forms for the new concrete sidewalk. Pavement, curb and sidewalk removals on the eastbound lane were to be completed this week. The storm sewer adjustments and removals on the westbound (north) side of Mequon Road were also finished. The installation of concrete sidewalk on the westbound (north) side of Mequon Road also began. Moving forward, crews will remove and replace drive entrances to Rick's Auto and River Centre Mall. In addition, fiber optic and vault boxes are in the process of being relocated. Lane closures will remain in effect and local businesses will remain accessible throughout the project. At certain times during the project, an alternative entrance may need to be used. To aid with traffic congestion, drivers on Mequon Road should merge near the lane closure. Take turns merging into one lane, like the teeth of a zipper coming together. This method can help reduce traffic backups by utilizing all available lanes until the merge point.

Special Election Set for Assembly District 24 Vacancy

During the Spring Election held on April 4, State Assembly District 24 Representative Dan Knodl was elected to represent State Senate District 8. To fill the vacated Assembly District 24 seat, Governor Tony Evers has called a Special Election for Tuesday, July 18. This will only involve residents living in Assembly District 24, namely Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 10, 11A and 12 (see ward map [here](#)). No primary will be needed for this election. Voters can report to their normal polling sites between 7:00 A.M. – 8:00 P.M. on July 18.
