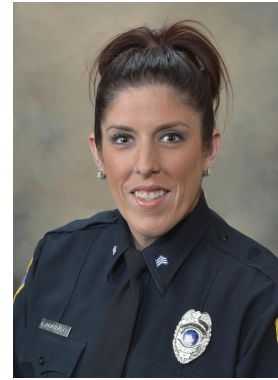

Sgt. Graycarek Named 'Crisis Intervention Team' Officer of the Year

Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training is a community initiative designed to improve the outcomes of police interactions with people living with mental illnesses. CIT programs are local partnerships between law enforcement, mental health providers, local NAMI chapters and other community stakeholders. In 2015, the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), Ozaukee Chapter, established a mental health training program with the support of former Ozaukee Sheriff Jim Johnson. Sergeant Lindsay Graycarek was a crucial member of this original team. Sgt. Graycarek has been part of numerous training sessions since then in support of the program. On June 15, Sgt. Graycarek was selected at the NAMI Wisconsin Symposium as the "Officer of the Year."



Sgt. Graycarek assisted with the 2022 NAMI Wisconsin Training Symposium and Advanced Training on Officer Wellness. She addresses the need for self-care, caring for fellow officers, suicide prevention, and ensures all officers have someone to go to in a time of need. In 2022, Sgt. Graycarek completed the application for the NAMI Ozaukee County Team to achieve the status of a NAMI Wisconsin Certified team. Sgt. Graycarek has been with the City of Mequon Police Department since November of 2002. She has held the positions of Patrol Officer, Field Training Officer, Field Training Supervisor, Detective, Crisis Negotiator, as well as the Critical Incident Debrief and Peer Support Lead, and most recently she has been serving as the Acting Patrol Captain.
