Preview of July 11 Common Council Meetings

Starting at 6:30 P.M on Tuesday, July 11, the Mequon Common Council, meeting as the Committee of the Whole, will engage in a policy discussion about possible industrial land uses in the southwest portion of the City. The Committee will also receive a presentation about the proposed implementation plan for a Classification & Compensation Study that was completed in 2022.

Starting at 7:30 P.M., the Common Council will hold its monthly meeting for July. The meeting will consist of a public hearing to consider amending the Mequon Municipal Code related to residential parking requirements for recreational vehicles and other vehicles, such as trailers and boats.

City Earns Governmental Finance Officers Association Award

The City has received the Governmental Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for its 2023 budget. The award represents a significant achievement by the City. It reflects the commitment of the governing body and staff to meet the highest principles of governmental budgeting. In order to receive the budget award, the entity must satisfy nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation. These guidelines are designed to assess how well an entity's budget serves as:

- a policy document
- a financial plan
- an operations guide
- a communications device

The budget document must be rated "proficient" in all four categories, and in the fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories, to receive the award. This is the 14th consecutive year that the City has received this award. See the attached letter from GFOA for further details.

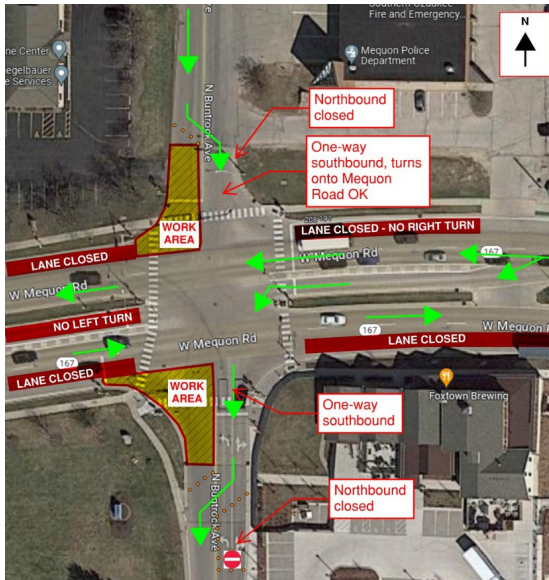


Absentee Voting Continues for July 18 Special Election

The Special Election for Assembly District 24 will be held on July 18. In-person absentee voting continues at City Hall during regular business hours through Friday, July 14. Mequon Road & OIT Crossing Project Update



Starting this past Monday, Buntrock Avenue at Mequon Road became one-way *southbound* only, in order to complete improvements at the intersection. The west side of the intersection as shown in the picture to the left will be closed for construction. Motorists should use Weston Drive or Steffen Drive as detour routes. The Spur 16 entrance will be fully open to traffic during work at the Buntrock intersection. The work is anticipated to be completed and reopened by the end of next week, weather permitting.
