City Records More Than 3 Inches of Rain on August 14

On Monday, August 14, the City of Mequon had a wet weather event. The rainfall was intense at times and was measured by the Department of Public Works (DPW) Combined Facility's rain gauge in the amount of 3.2 inches of accumulation. Fortunately, any corresponding infiltration and inflow did not result in any issues for Mequon's sanitary sewer system. Notably, the City's DPW Sewer Maintenance crew works diligently on a daily basis to operate and maintain a reliable system. They are responsible for the

operation and capital improvements on 167 miles of sanitary sewers, 3,900 structures, 23 lift stations and 18 miles of force mains within the public right-of-way and upon easements that service nearly 8,000 customers. The Division's goal is to maintain capacity in the sanitary sewer collection system in dry and wet weather and to program capital improvements for necessary improvements.

WisDOT Provides I-43 Construction Updates



As the Wisconsin Department of Transportation continues work on the I-43 North-South reconstruction project, several areas throughout the City continue to be impacted. As of Thursday, the newly constructed I-43 southbound and northbound exit ramps to Port Washington Road have opened to traffic. Elsewhere, long-term lane closures near the intersection of Port Washington and Mequon Roads are underway through the fall for utility work in advance of reconstructing the Mequon Road Interchange.
