Shift Coverage Improves for Southern Ozaukee Fire Department

The Southern Ozaukee Fire & EMS Department recently completed a comparison of fire and EMS shift coverage for the first six months of 2023. The data showed only 1% or about 470 hours of shift coverage that



have gone unfilled since the merger of the Mequon and Thiensville Fire Departments. This is down from 16% of unfilled shifts in 2022 and 24% of unfilled shifts in 2021. Summarily, the merger of the paid-on-call members and the hiring of additional full-time personnel have made it possible to assure increased staffing to better serve Mequon and Thiensville residents.
