Buntrock Sidewalk Project Completed



The City's contractor recently completed a sidewalk extension project on Buntrock Avenue south of Mequon Road. The new segment will provide continuous sidewalk access from Mequon Road to Steffen Middle School and Wilson Elementary School. The project was completed with a series of other improvement projects that are being implemented within the Mequon Town Center District.

Mequon Nature Preserve Begins Efforts to Grow a Forest



The Mequon Nature Preserve staff are excited to start planting 43,000 native trees and shrubs in the newest 57-acre restoration area on the northeast side of the Preserve.

These plantings are a part of the Reforestation and Wetland Restoration Program being conducted by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewage District. The goal of this program is to plant 6 million trees and restore 4,000 acres of wetlands in the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds: all in the next ten years. This will help improve local water quality, balance the water cycle, reduce potential floods, restore habitat, create stronger more resilient watersheds, and capture carbon from the atmosphere.

The Mequon Nature Preserve is the first project area for this program. MNP staff and volunteers will be planting 1,000 potted trees and shrubs in Fall 2023; 20,000 tree seedlings in Spring 2024; 1,000 potted trees and shrubs in Fall 2024; 20,000 tree seedlings in Spring 2025; and 1,000 potted trees and shrubs in Fall 2025. Residents can assist MNP staff with planting by joining Restoration Rangers on Thursdays at 9:00 A.M. from May - October or corporate groups can sign up for a weekday volunteer session.
