Aldermanic Nomination Papers Due on January 2

As a reminder, Aldermanic seats in Districts 6, 7 and 8 will be up for reelection in 2024. Each position is elected to a three-year term beginning on the third Tuesday in April. To appear on the ballot, candidates must complete candidacy paperwork and obtain 20 - 40 signatures from residents in the corresponding district. Nomination Papers and election forms are due in the City Clerk's Office no later than 5:00 P.M. on Tuesday, January 2, 2024. 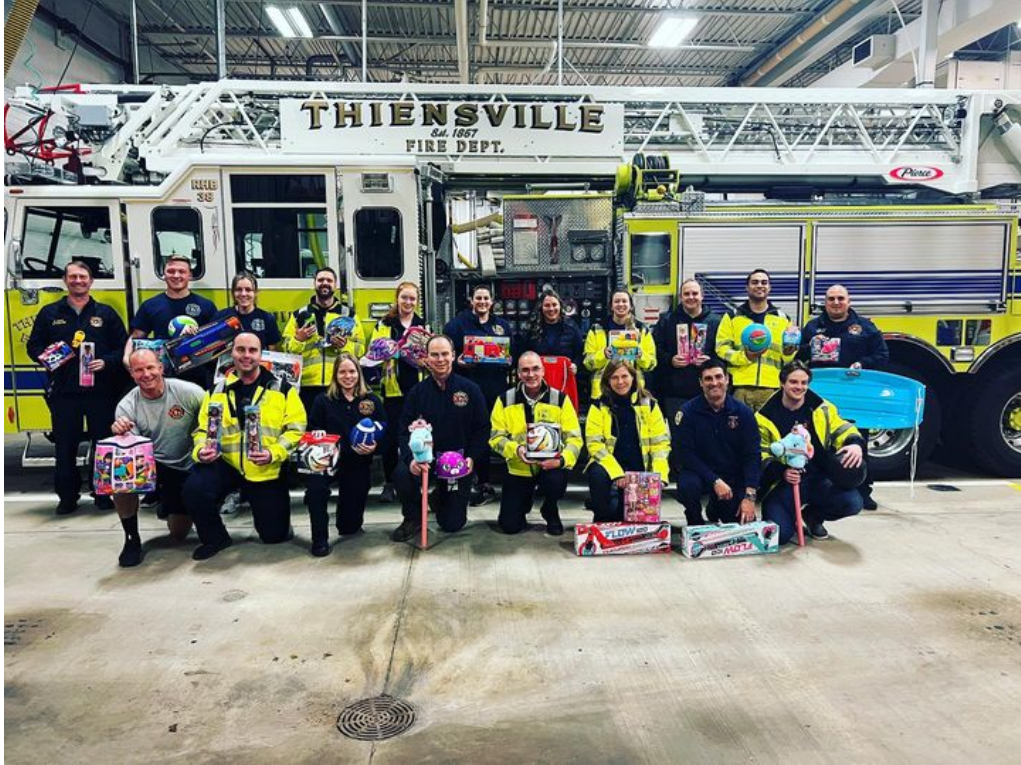
