Preview of February 13 Common Council Meetings

Starting at 6:45 P.M. on Tuesday, February 13, the Mequon Common Council, meeting as the Committee of the Whole, will receive an update on South Central Zoning Options which applies to the area bounded by Baehr Road to the east, County Line Road to the south, Enterprise Drive to the west and Donges Bay Road to the north.

Starting at 7:30 P.M., the Common Council will hold its monthly meeting. A representative from the MKE 2024 Host Committee will give a brief presentation about what to expect this July when Milwaukee hosts the Republican National Presidential Nominating Convention. The business portion of the meeting will then take place and the Council will consider:

- Approving a Development & Dedication Agreement with the Mequon-Thiensville Little League for batting cage improvements at Rennie Field
- Awarding a design contract for replacement of various HVAC units and other Council Chambers upgrades at City Hall to Strang in the amount of \$90,000
- Approving the purchase of two Steril-Koni mobile column lifts from Midwest Equipment Specialists, Inc. in the amount of 30,994
- Authorizing supplemental inspection services in excess of \$25,000 during the 2024 construction season with the following engineering firms: Graef, Kapur & Associates, M-Squared North Shore Engineering, Smith and Ruckert-Mielke, Inc.
- Approving a Second Amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the Village of Thiensville establishing the Southern Ozaukee Fire and EMS Department

The following fees apply:

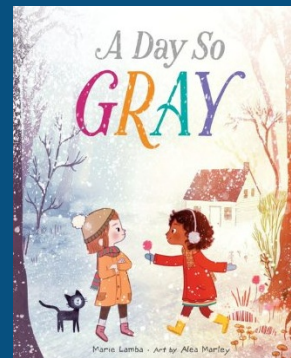
Not neutered male or not spayed female	\$15
