Brush site and burn permits are available for purchase with cash, check, or credit card in the Finance Department at Mequon City Hall, Monday - Friday from 8:00 A.M. through 4:30 P.M., or at the Mequon Police Department. Those wishing to purchase a permit will have to present either a driver's license or utility bill showing their Mequon address upon purchase. The Ozaukee County Pollinator Plant Sale is now open and accepting orders. Spring will be here before long and now is a great time to plan for assisting local pollinator species. The County Land and Water Management Department is now accepting orders for the pollinator sale. All orders should be placed online. New species have been added to the sale this year. The cost of a ¼ flat - 8 plants is \$20, ½ flat - 16 plants is \$37, a full flat - 32 plants is \$65. Click on the www.flowersale.co.ozaukee.wi.us link for more information and to place your order. The deadline for the sale is April 12; no orders will be accepted after that date. Just like last year, plant pick-up will be in mid-June. There will be some extra plants available for purchase on the order pick-up day.

Deer Baiting and Feeding Ban Begins in Ozaukee County



Due to a recent chronic wasting disease detection in a buck in Sheboygan County, Ozaukee County is now mandated by state law to a two-year baiting and feeding ban since it is an adjoining county within 10 miles of a CWD detection.
