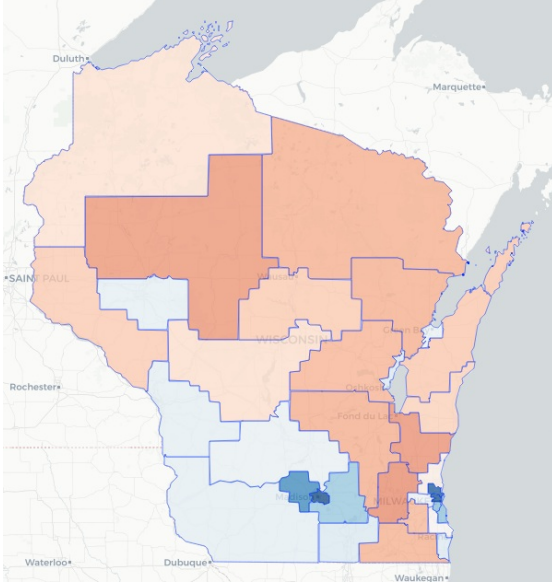

### New Legislative Maps to Affect Mequon

Governor Evers signed new legislative maps into law last week. The City of Mequon is currently represented by State Senator Knodl and the new boundaries have drawn Senator Knodl and Senator



Stroebel into the same district, District 8. Even-numbered Senate seats are up for reelection in November, and Senator Knodl has announced he will not be running for this seat. Therefore, Senator Strobel will be the incumbent should he choose to run. Both of Mequon's State Assembly seats are also up for reelection in November. Voters will continue to vote at the same polling site as they have for the past four years since the City's last redistricting in 2021. ## City Now Accepting Payment Cards at 3 Main Facilities



In February, the City began accepting payment cards at City Hall, Public Works, and the Public Safety Building, leveraging a fully integrated solution with the City's financial system, Tyler MUNIS. Previously, cash and checks were the only allowable forms of payments for point-of-sale transactions. Now, customers can pay in person with a payment (credit or debit) card for any type of service, in any dollar amount. The one exception is property tax payments; they can be paid online via payment card or e-check. Notably, there is a 3.25% convenience fee (minimum fee of \$2.00) that is charged by Tyler MUNIS and the credit card companies, which will be included as a part of any electronic transaction. Attached is a **full schedule** outlining the City's available electronic payment options for e-commerce and point-of-sale transactions. ## Revolving Loan Funds Available for New or Expanding Businesses

The City of Mequon's Revolving Loan Fund is an economic development program administered to create and retain permanent jobs and assist businesses in locating or expanding within the City. Funds from the program can be used for the following activities:

- Acquisition of land, buildings, and fixed equipment
- Site preparation, rehabilitation of buildings or demolition of buildings
- Working capital
- Buyouts by purchase of assets or stock

Funding is based on the creation or retention of full-time equivalent jobs. All jobs are to be created within 24 months from the date of the loan approval. Currently, the

City's Revolving Loan Fund program has 14 active loans with additional funding capacity of \$470,000. The program is administered by the City's Community Development Department and Ozaukee County Economic Development Corporation.
