In-Person Absentee Voting is Underway



In-person absentee voting began on Tuesday and will continue next week through Thursday, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. Additionally, absentee voting will be held next Friday, March 29 between 8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M. Voting takes place in the Council Chambers, so please enter through the doors facing Cedarburg Road. A handicap-accessible entrance to City Hall, which is adjacent to the facility's elevator system, is located on the west side of the building facing Rennie Field.

Annual Dog License Renewal Reminder

All dogs in the City are required to be licensed annually. To obtain a new or renew a license, please visit the Finance Department at City Hall. A current rabies immunization statement from a veterinarian must be on file or accompany the payment to receive a license. The Finance Department accepts checks, cash, or credit card. A late charge of \$5 will be applied to any dogs licensed after 3/31/24. The fees are:

Non-neutered male or unspayed female: \$15

Neutered male or spayed female: \$10

Celebrate Heritage Days at Jonathan Clark House March 25-26
