

I-43 NORTHBOUND LONG-TERM LANE CLOSURE TO BEGIN

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has begun reconstructing 1.5 miles of I-43 between Capitol Drive and north of Hampton Avenue as part of the I-43 URT (Union Refrigerator Transit Company) bridge project.

The following long-term lane and ramp closures are scheduled to begin 6 a.m., Saturday, October 2:

- I-43 northbound, between Capitol Drive and just south of Silver Spring Drive, is scheduled to be reduced to two lanes through late 2021.
- Fiebrantz Avenue entrance ramp to I-43 northbound is scheduled to close through late 2021.


I-43 Northbound Alternate Route:

 Motorists are encouraged to use the Green Bay Avenue exit ramp, north to Silver Spring Drive, east to Port Washington Road, south to I-43 NORTH entrance ramp to get around the closure.

Fiebrantz Avenue Detour Route:

 Motorists are encouraged to use Green Bay Avenue north to Silver Spring Drive, east to Port Washington Road, south to I-43 NORTH entrance ramp to get around the closure.
