

Mequon Road & OIT Crossing Improvements Project



Weekly Update - July 24 to July 28

The project is currently on schedule and is anticipated to conclude in late October. Lane closures will continue throughout summer and will be opened when possible.

- Rough grading in the street terrace areas to begin.
- Installing topsoil in the street terrace areas to begin.
- Work on the new lighting and traffic signal bases continues along the corridor.
- Local businesses will remain accessible throughout the project.
- Both Spur 16 entrances are open to traffic.
- At certain times during the project, an alternative entrance may need to be used.



Work Forecast - July 31 to August 4



- Installing topsoil in the street terrace areas to continue.
- Traffic Control Pattern to switch this week to begin work in the median areas. The outside lane will be open
- Median curb and pavement removals to begin.
- Work on the new lighting and traffic signal bases continues along the corridor.
- Local businesses will remain accessible throughout the project.
- At certain times during the project, an alternative entrance may need to be used.

Traffic tip:

Drivers on Mequon Road should merge near the lane closure. Take turns merging into one lane, like the teeth of a zipper coming together. This method can help reduce congestion and prevent traffic backups by utilizing all available lanes until the merge point.
