Mequon Road & OIT Crossing Improvements Project



The project is currently on schedule and is anticipated to conclude in late October. Lane closures will continue throughout summer and will be opened when possible.

- The traffic control pattern was switched over on Tuesday for the Stage 3 median work to commence.
- Sawcutting for pavement removals for Stage 3 work is complete.
- Installing topsoil in the street terrace areas is complete
- Work on the new lighting and traffic signal bases continues along the corridor.
- Local businesses will remain accessible throughout the project.



Work Forecast - August 7 to August 11



- Replacing storm sewer inlets and manholes will begin in the median areas of Mequon Road.
- Work on the new lighting and traffic signal bases will continue along the corridor.



Traffic tip:

Drivers on Mequon Road should merge near the lane closure. Take turns merging into one lane, like the teeth of a zipper coming together. This method can help reduce congestion and prevent traffic backups by utilizing all available lanes until the merge point.
