

- Only brush and yard waste from a residential lot in the City of Mequon is accepted.
- Property owner must accompany or meet commercial service at site.
- Commercial dumping is not allowed.
- Do not dump anything outside of the fenced site.
- Violators will be cited and/or have permit revoked.

Show permit or online receipt to attendant.

Brush will be inspected.

Once approved place brush in the designated areas.



Materials Accepted

Grass, leaves, weeds, pumpkins, garden waste Brush and branches up to 12" in diameter "only" Soft body green herbaceous material under 1" in diameter



Materials NOT Accepted

Garbage, Invasive weeds logs, stumps, railroad ties, construction lumber, rocks, sod, etc.

Invasive weeds must be collected separately from other yard waste.

Place the whole plant (or their flower/seed heads) in a clear bag labeled "Invasive Plants— Please Landfill". Property owners should place these bags out for collection by your contracted licensed garbage hauler. Contracted licensed haulers are authorized to accept these invasive plants by the DNR.

Invasive species to be bagged and collected by your contracted licensed garbage hauler:

garlic mustard, purple loosestrife, spotted knapweed, leafy spurge, crown vetch, dames rocket, yellow and white clover, wild parsnips, Canada thistle, common and cut leaf teasel, birds-foot trefoil and tansy.
