HOLDING TANK AGREEMENT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The installation of holding tanks is regulated by the Wisconsin Administrative Code, Ozaukee County Land and Water Management and City of Mequon Ordinances.

- Step 1: The owner is advised that a copy of the recorded "City of Mequon Holding Tank Agreement" is required to obtain a Sanitary Permit from the Ozaukee County Land and Water Management. Service contract agreements are obtained from a licensed hauler. The owner fills out the holding tank application and also submits the following:
 - Notice of ordinance violation from Ozaukee County Land and Water Management. (Not required if a replacement)
 - Plat of survey. (Not required if a replacement holding tank)
 - Executed service contract agreement from a licensed waste hauler.
- Step 2: The applicant provides the executed 3-page holding tank agreement document (last revision date 8/16/2023). The applicant provides the information requested on the holding tank agreement on page 1 and the owners sign on page 3 and have their signatures notarized. Notarization can be done at the City Clerk's Office in City Hall for free.
- **Step 3:** Staff reviews the application and holding tank agreement for completeness and accuracy.
- **Step 4:** The holding tank agreement is transmitted to the Mayor and City Clerk for signing.
- **Step 5:** The executed document is transmitted to the Register of Deeds office in Port Washington for recording. The document can be recorded as follows:
 - a. The document is mailed to the Register of Deeds Office.
 - b. The owner can have the document recorded and return the original copy to the City.

Step 6: Once the City receives the recorded holding tank agreement document a copy of it is sent to the property owner with a cover letter and the receipt.

Step 7: The original holding tank agreement document is placed in the City address file

In the event the holding tank of a property is eliminated with the installation of a mound system or connected to sanitary sewer, a "Cancellation of Holding Tank Agreement" form is to be filled out, signed by the Director of Public Works, and recorded at the Register of Deeds Office.
