

CHAPTER 2

EROSION CONTROL PERMIT

The Erosion Control is regulated by the City of Meguon Code of Ordinances 58-671 to 58-677, Erosion and Storm Water Runoff Control Regulations.

- Step 1:** Owner or agent files application with erosion control plan. Application includes the application fee.
- Step 2:** Staff reviews the application and erosion control plan following the Standard Specifications for Land Development (this can be found on the City's web site).
- Step 3:** Staff advises applicant of approval or modifications to plan.
- Step 4:** Applicant/owner installs erosion control measures and contacts the City for inspection.
- Step 5:** Engineering Department inspects the installation for compliance with the ordinances and approved plan.
- Step 6:** Staff issues erosion control permit.
- Step 7:** Staff provides a copy of the erosion control permit to the Engineering Supervisor and address/subdivision file.
- Step 8:** Staff conducts periodic inspections.
- Step 9:** Owner or agent files Notice of Termination once final site stabilization has been achieved.
- Step 10:** Staff conducts final inspection and approves or provides comment.
