- **YES** The property owner prefers to be removed from the Sanitary Sewer Service Area and not be in the City Sewer Tax District.
- The property will become exempt from the City of Mequon Sewer Tax District and any associated charges.
- The property will continue to use a private onsite wastewater treatment system.
- The property will not be allowed to connect to the sanitary sewer system in the future, without a sewer service area amendment. (A sewer service area amendment takes approximately 6 to 9 months and requires approvals by the City SUDC, MMSD and SEWRPC).

- NO The property owner would prefer the opportunity to remain in the Sanitary Sewer Service Area and incur Sewer Utility Tax District charges.
- The property could remain in the Sanitary Sewer Service Area and incur City Sewer Utility Tax District charges.
